What are chemical skin peels?

Chemical peels exfoliate the outer layers of dead skin cells and reveal a new skin layer with improved tone, texture and color. Peels take away dead skin cells and compel the generation of new skin, thus eliminating fine lines, wrinkles, sun spots, blotchiness, dryness, acne and a host of other mild skin conditions.

Can I combine a peel with a MicroDermAbrasion?

Absolutely. This is by far the most effective way to improve your skin's appearance. A combination program of chemical peel and microdermabrasion should also be followed for 3 treatments for optimal results.

What type of peels are offered at Rejuvenate?

We offer a variety of peels and formulations that are each customized to your skin type and to the condition which is being addressed.

What does a treatment feel like?

Upon application, patients feel a slight tingling or stinging which subsides after a few minutes.

What can I expect immediately after a treatment?

Your skin will be given a youthful glow. It is not uncommon for people to notice your new texture and compliment it. Immediately following the treatment, your skin may be slightly pink, but nothing drastic. Any redness will disappear before the end of the day.

Will my skin literally "peel"?

Chemical peels remove the outer layers of skin to reduce or eliminate the appearance of a number of skin imperfections and conditions. After a patient undergoes a skin peel, the treated layers of skin gradually flake away, revealing a fresh new layer of skin. Generally, the peeling lasts a few days.

Which type of chemical peel is right for me?

Our qualified staff can determine which type of skin peel is appropriate for you. In deciding who is a good candidate for a chemical peel, we will consider several factors, including the patient's medical history, pigmentation, the skin condition to be treated (especially the extent of sun damage) and the patient's goals.

Can chemical peels be performed on areas other than the face?

Though peels are appropriate for the face, the skin on any part of the body can be treated in this way. As with facial chemical peels, body peels address acne, the effects of sun damage, even out skin pigmentation and improve skin texture.
